Make sure routine vaccines are up to date.

Vaccine's Needed -
DP tetanus
Hep A&B*
Typhoid
Malaria

Consult your doctor for recommended vaccines, medications, and travel health. Keep RX medication in original bottle. Bring OTC and enough RX medications you normally use. Don't expect your destination to have your normal medications.

It can be very humid and hot. You will need to be prepared to walk a great deal in the heat on rough terrain.

Note -
Insect repellent is a must!
Do not pet animals/ risk being bitten by stray dogs.
Do not drink the water.

Draft Schedule:

16 Sept - Depart PNS Arrive in Guatemala City. Meal in local cafe then 45 min drive to Barberena. Stay in AIRBNB or a Hotel.

17 Sept - Bfast in AIRBNB. Worship @ local village church Los Chilitos. Multiple church activities on Sunday. Free afternoon.

18 Sept - Ministry projects at Los Chilitos

19 Sept - Ministry projects at Los Chilitos

20 Sept - Ministry at Los Chilitos and help at Wed church service. Kids activities and meals.

21 Sept - Ministry projects at Los Chilitos. Eve - Pack for trip to Antigua

22 Sept - Check out. Day touring Antigua. Hotel stay in Antigua or Guatemala City.

23 Sept -Depart for airport to PNS

Passport must be valid through May 2024. If your passport expires prior to May 2024 - please re-new it now.

Estimated Costs - \$1800.00

Air Travel: \$700.00 (could vary) Due by 1 June.

Ground Transport: \$100.00 per person (if we have 10 people)

Meals: \$ 200.00 (local meals and sharing meals in AIRBNB)

Accommodations - \$150 for hotel in Antigua/Gmala City.

Week near ministry area in AIRBNB - \$600.00 per person.

Don't forget travel, shopping, and touring days. Some meals could be at western fast food establishments. Not included in costs.

AIRBNB's can have full kitchens and some sleep up to 15.
